Box Hill Institute's international inbound students are supported prior to and throughout their training, with a dedicated team of international student support staff providing accommodation, language, academic and social support.

Box Hill Institute's income from all international activity represents approximately 19 per cent of its overall income, making its international arm a significant and strategic part of its operations.
